PACCO Regular College Scholarship Program

Deadline: March 15, 2018

Each year, PACCO awards up to 4 scholarships of \$500 each to high school seniors or current college students. Scholarships are awarded to recognize volunteer work, extra-curricular activities as well as academic achievement. High school seniors or current college students of Filipino descent, legal resident of Oregon and SW Washington are eligible to apply. Applicants must enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at any accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school in Oregon or SW Washington no later than the fall term of 2018-2019 school year.

PACCO Scholarship committee will select recipients based on the following criteria: number of community volunteer service hours; leadership awards and honors; appraisal/recommendation completed by a supervisor, leader or teacher; an essay and a grade point average of 3.00 or better and financial need.

Scholarship funds will be dispersed directly to the school after enrollment has been verified. Award winners will be expected to participate or volunteer in future PACCO events. Scholarships will be awarded at a banquet on April 19, 2018 and a ticket for the awardee and one guest will be provided.
