2019 PACCO Scholarship Application

PACCO Regular College Scholarship Program

Deadline: March 15, 2019

Each year, PACCO awards up to 4 scholarships for at least \$500 each to high school seniors or current college students. Scholarships are awarded to recognize volunteer work, extra-curricular activities as well as academic achievement. High school seniors or current college students of Filipino descent, legal resident of Oregon and SW Washington are encouraged to apply. Applicants must enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at any accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school in Oregon or SW Washington no later than the fall term of 2019-2020 school year.

The PACCO Scholarship committee will select recipients based on the following criteria:

- number of community volunteer service hours;
- leadership awards and honors;
- appraisal/recommendation completed by a supervisor, leader or teacher;
- an essay;
- a grade point average of 3.00 or better;
- and financial need.

To apply for this scholarship, please complete the application on the following page and submit documents as noted. The form is also available on the PACCO website at www.pacco.org/scholarship.html.

Scholarships will be awarded at the Asian Reporter Foundation banquet at a date to be announced in spring 2019. One ticket for the awardee and one parent or guest will be provided.

Please note that PACCO may use your statements for future marketing communications. Please also send documentation to verify enrollment as noted in your application packet of documents. After PACCO has confirmed and verified your enrollment, funds will be dispersed for the scholarship award directly to the school or university.

Award winners are expected to participate or volunteer for future PACCO events through graduation and beyond. Your application confirms agreement to join PACCO's mailing list and receive future communications. Membership with PACCO is not required but highly encouraged.
