

# COVID-19 Relief Funds Grant Recipients

## Oregon Small Business Relief Fund Awards

Business Oregon released the latest of the state's recovery efforts for Oregon small businesses suffering in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic—funding to stand up local small business grant programs across the state. The Oregon Legislature and Governor Kate Brown allocated \$5 million from the state's General Fund, which we combined with another \$5 million redirected from existing programs at Business Oregon.

Round 1—eligible applicants are cities, counties, and economic development districts that have existing small business COVID-relief programs or will stand up new programs to issue grants to local small businesses.

Round 2—eligible applicants are community development financial institutions (CDFIs) and economic development districts (EDDs).
